Since the College has to go under the 2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle of Accreditation. The validity of fist cycle is up to October 29<sup>th</sup> 2022. So, all the 4 AQARs are completed and submitted before going for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Cycle of the Accreditation.
